

# Ten Crime Watch Tips for Home Safety

- Lock doors and windows
- Lock all doors at night and every time you leave the house.
- Secure windows and sliding doors with secondary blocking devices..
- Crime-proof outside areas
- Lighting is one of the most cost-effective deterrents to burglary so keep yard, porch, garage doors, pathways and entrances well-lit at night.
- Use motion detecting lights which turn on automatically as someone approaches.
- Consider light timers for exterior lighting and driveway motion monitors
- Get to know your neighbors
- Get to know your neighbors on each side of your home and across the street.
- Ask neighbors to pick up mail and park in your driveway to give appearance of occupancy while on vacation.
- Consistently use your security alarm system

- Display alarm company signs and decals on the windows and lawn; burglars will usually bypass a property with visible alarm signs.
- Consider installing an exterior alarm and a strobe light connected to your home alarm system.
- Protect yourself with lock and key
- Don't hide keys. Leave a key with a trusted family member, friend or neighbor.
- All entryways should have a sturdy deadbolt lock installed into the frame of the door.
- Protect your home when traveling
- Call the HCSO Vacation Watch number before you leave home at 281-446-9155
- Inform a trusted neighbor of your travel plans and ask them to collect mail and watch your home while you are away.
- Consider using automatic timers to switch interior lights on and off at preset times.
- Protect your valuables
- Gate latches, garage doors, and shed doors

should be locked with high quality locks.

- Keep home inventories of valuables including serial numbers, pictures, and sales receipts
- Teach home safety to your kids
- Never let them allow anyone into your home without permission or let a caller at the door know they are alone.
- Be sure they know how to call 911
- Have an emergency plan
- Have important phone numbers such as police and fire by the phone.
- If something looks questionable- a slit screen or broken window or open doordon't go in. Call the police.
- Take a stand and join the Summerwood Crime Watch Committee
