



A Flip Zone traveled to Long Beach, California to compete in the USA Gymnastics Junior Olympic Trampoline and Power Tumbling National Championships on July 4 - 11, 2012. A Flip Zone athlete, Daniel Molstad (16 yrs. old) earned the honor to compete in the competition. Daniel was second place at the completion of his round of competition and held on to one of the top eight places following the preliminary competition qualifying to move on to compete in the finals competition. Dmitri is coach to Savannah Vinsant the 2012 Olympian for Team USA - Trampoline. Daniel and his coach Patti have traveled to Russia and Belarus with Dmitri and Savannah to compete in the 2010 Slavic Games Trampoline Competition.

A Flip Zone teaches with progressions and uses the Junior Olympic Program and guidelines established by USA Gymnastics. Koby and Daniel have progressed in the USA Gymnastics system. Daniel has also learned to judge the sport. Daniel judges some sessions at local competitions in addition to competing as an athlete. Jamar (4 yrs.

old) is currently the youngest athlete at A Flip Zone. A Flip Zone also works with children and adults with special needs to build confidence, strength, balance and coordination.
