





'FORE Cy-Fair', the Cy-Fair Chamber's Annual Golf Tournament will be held at Longwood Golf Club on Monday, October 17 with an 11:30 am scramble-shotgun start. Registration begins at 9:30 am. Putting contests and lunch will be available prior to the shotgun start. Dinner and awards will be held at 5:00 pm. Individual golfers will be treated to lunch provided by Backyard Grill, a delicious fajita dinner, free beverages throughout the day, and green fees and cart.

A portion of the proceeds from the tournament will benefit the Adam Skinner Memorial Scholarship Fund of the Cy-Fair Educational Foundation. Adam Skinner was a 12 year-old Cy-Fair youth who died in a tragic traffic accident and a scholarship endowment has been established in his memory. The Chamber has contributed more than \$74,000 to the endowment.

The title underwriter for the 2011 tournament is Texas Emergency Care Center – Cypress. This is the second year for TECC to underwrite the tournament. North Cypress Medical Center added their support to the event with the Lone Star Sponsorship.


