#### **ACC APPROVAL MUST BE OBTAINED BEFOREYOU:**

- Paint exterior of your house Add a pool. (even if the same color)
- Repair or replace your roof.
- Repair or install a new fence.
- Add a storage or tool shed.
- Add a satellite dish.
- Add an antenna.
- Install siding.
- Install a patio or patio cover.
- Replace garage doors.
- Add a room addition.

- Add a deck.
- Add a basketball goal.
- Add solar/screen windows of doors.
- Replace your mailbox.
- Add burglar bars.
- Add landscaping.
- Add sidewalks.
- Add exterior lighting.



An ACC application must be completely filled out by the resident and mailed to SCS. SCS will approve the application and notify the resident. If they have any questions SCS might contact the board member responsible for Architectural review for further explanation of the improvement.

# Remember EARTH DAY everyday!

Do your part by recycling your items in the recycling bin the neighborhood has provided, and then for all those other items that can't be put in the bin.

Visit your local recycling center, City of Houston Recycling Plant:

Windfern NBHRD Depository 6023 Windfern 713-895-1002

It is open everyday from 10:00 a.m.-6:30 p.m. in the fall, and in the winter from 9-5:30 p.m. The plant recycles: glass, steel, paper (any kind), cardboard, plastic bags, batteries- (cars, remote cars, kiddie cars, household), and used motor oil.

To recycle - No utility bill is needed, you can take your items for recycling as much as you want and you don't have to be a resident of the city of Houston!

But to dump, you will need a city of Houston water bill or an electric bill, and you must also be a resident of the City of Houston. The facility will accept tree and brush debris up to 4X's a month. You can also dump up to 10 tires per month, and they take old appliances, furniture, and a/c units (Freon must be removed).

The recycling plant on 5900 Westpark (by Chimney Rock) called Westpark Recycling Center will take your old paint, chemicals, solvents etc. too. Here is also link for all of the 25 City of Houston recycling facilities. http://www.houstontx.gov/solidwaste/recyclinglocations.pdf.






# **ADOPTION COALITION OF TEXAS**
