



our youngest Kindergarten Daisy troops, to helping older girls grow in confidence and character as they discover


> their strengths, connect with others and take action to make the world a better place. Girls can choose to join Girl Scout troops, be independent Girl



CWC is a service organization that gives back to the community. This means that all funds raised will go right back to the community in the




form of scholarships for graduating high school seniors, at Lone Star College, Cy-Fair and grants to other non-profits in our community, as well.
