



PUBLIC SERVICE VOTER INFORMATION

For Residents of Lakes on Eldridge and Lakes on Eldridge North - Precinct 155

The General Election for 2012 will be held on Tuesday, November 6. America is blessed to have a Constitutional Republic that allows the people to select their representatives. We can have a voice and make a difference in our government only if we participate in the process.

Texas voters will select from a long list of contested races which include the President of the United States, US Senator, every U.S. Congressional Representative, State-wide races including Railroad Commissioner, State Supreme Court and Court of Criminal Appeals judges, State Senator and Representative, judicial positions for the First Court of Appeals, District Courts, Family District Courts, county officials, and county judicial positions for civil courts, criminal courts, constables and justices of the peace.

If you are not registered to vote, you can obtain a voter's registration application and register to vote 30 days before the election. The last day to register to vote is October 9. You can obtain a voter registration application from the Harris County Voter Registrar at 713-368-VOTE (8683) or online at www.hcvoter.net. You must be a U.S. citizen to register to vote, and you must be at least 17 years and 10 months old. Your voter registration will become effective 30 days after it is received or on your 18th birthday, whichever is later. If you move to another county, you must re-register in the county of your new residence. To vote you must be a resident of Harris County, not a felon, and have not been declared mentally incompetent by a court of law. You must be registered to be eligible to vote. Registered voters are issued a Voter Registration Certificate, which currently has a yellow background. Bring it when you go to vote, although a photographic identification card will work just as well.

It is recommended to vote early in person or by mail. To vote early in person appear in person at any Early Voting Location with your Voter Registration Certificate or photo ID during the early voting dates, October 22 to November 2. The closest polling location to Lakes on Eldridge for early voting is The Bear Creek Park Community Center. To obtain a ballot by mail, contact the County Clerk at 713-755-6965 or online at www.harrisvotes.com. However, if you request a ballot by mail then decide to vote in person, you must give the mail ballot to the Election Judge to be allowed to vote in person.

To vote on Election Day you need to vote at the voting location of your precinct. Your precinct is number 155, and the polling place will be at Kirk Elementary on Tanner Road. Polls will be open from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM on Tuesday, November 6th. If you need further assistance, please contact Precinct Chairman Russell Rush at 281-772-4390 or rushgroup@aol.com.
