

Northwest Flyers Youth Track Club Registration


The Northwest Flyers Youth Track Club will celebrate its 26th Anniversary Season by hosting its annual free information and registration breakfast on Saturday, February 2nd, 2013, for all boys, girls and their parents who are interested in joining for the 2013 track season. The breakfast starts promptly at 8:30 AM at the Cypress Creek Christian Community Center Forum located at 6823 Cypresswood Dr., Spring, TX, 77379.

The free breakfast is the opportunity for youth athletes to register for the club's 2013 spring/summer track season, and to meet the Northwest Flyers coaches, staff, and other new and returning athletes. 

Electricity From The Sun

All of us living here in Houston are acutely aware that the sun is a plentiful, rather unrelenting source of sunlight (and heat, as its unwelcome byproduct). And many of us have likely thought: "If only I could harness even just some of that free sunlight..." But if you were to install a solar array or solar panel system on the roof of your home, how much electricity would it generate, and more importantly how much money could you save on your electric bills?

It turns out you can easily get some estimates of the savings without having to know much about solar energy or contacting a solar installer or solar company. The National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL), operated by the US Department of Energy, has a website that allows anyone to calculate the amount of electricity generated by a PV (photovoltaic) system (a.k.a. solar panel array system). You can go to their website 'rredc.nrel.gov' and look for the calculators. Or for your convenience, here is a shortened link that takes directly to the calculator for Houston: http://goo.gl/bRurv.

Once there, for your initial estimate you can use the default information presented and just click on "calculate" at the bottom. On the results page you will see that in Houston a south facing solar panel array (i.e., Array Azimuth = 180 degrees) that's built for 4 kW of electricity generation is expected to generate 4879 kWh and save you \$473.26 in a year, if your rate is indeed 9.7 cents per kWh. If you want a better estimate, there are 3 main settings you can go back and change:

- 1. Array Azimuth in degrees.
- 2. DC Rating in kW.
- 3. Cost of Electricity in cents.

Array Azimuth: This is the direction the panel will face, expressed as degrees from north. South is best, because that gets it the most sunlight, hence the default value of 180 degrees. But if you cannot place it that way, southwest (225 degrees) or southeast (135 degrees) are second best.

DC Rating: This is the "size" in kW of your solar array, i.e., its capacity to generate electricity, which depends on the number of solar panels in your proposed system. The default of 4kW is the size of a typical roof installation. Adding solar panels to your array increases your upfront costs of course, but also increases the amount of electricity generated and therefore increases the potential savings.

Cost of Electricity: The default in the calculator is the Texas state average of 9.7 cents per kWh. If that is not what you are paying (or expect to pay) your electricity provider, change it accordingly to get a more realistic estimate.

When you are done you will have a fairly accurate prediction of the benefit of installing solar generation on your home, and you can start to consider whether doing so may make financial sense for you and your family. If you have any questions, please contact Chris lee at leec89@gmail.com.
