

Trees over the side walk need to be trimmed to 8 feet and trees blocking stop signs or any other street signs need to be trimmed so that the signs are visible for all drivers and the trees do not hit HISD's school busses or other vehicles. We have been contacted by the school district, informing us that if the trees are not trimmed so that their busses do not get hit, they will cease to pick up kids from Plum Creek. So lets work together as a community and get these trees trimmed.
