



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APPLE CRUMBLE

The votes have been counted and the results are in. By 22 votes the winner of the Pie Contest is Apple Crumble submitted by Janice Owens. Thanks to everyone for partipating.

You need one pie shell.

Combine 1 1/2 sticks of cold butter (cut into pieces), 1 1/2 cups of flour, ³/₄ cup of light brown sugar, 1/3 cup of sugar, ¹/₄ tsp. salt and 1/4 tsp. of cinnamon until mixture resembles small pebbles. Set aside.

Combine 5.5 pounds of peeled, cored and cut apples with 1 tablespoon lemon juice, 1/8 teaspoon salt, 3 tbs. flour, and 1 cup of sugar. Mix well.

Place apple mixture in pie shell and bake 45 minutes at 350 degrees. Adds crumble mixture and bake an additional 45 minutes or until golden brown.

Best served cool.

Around Colleyville

Just in time for the holidays, the city of Colleyville and local businesses have joined forces to introduce the Colleyville CloseBuy consumer card, known as 'Ccard," a loyalty reward and discount card program. The card is free to Colleyville patrons and is available at participating retailers. Look for the "Do you have yours?" decal at participating restaurants and retailers

Oncor will be trimming trees along Glade Road and Collevville Boulevard. Trimming was scheduled to begin in November and is done to prevent power outages caused by contact between the trees and power lines

In January, Colleyville's police and fire departments will begin accepting applications for their respective citizen academies. Each starts classes in February and is free to residents, 16 years and older. Applications for both academies are available online at
