2012 Voting at the Wortham Villages Clubhouse

This was the first year that our neighborhood had voting at our clubhouse and it was new to us all. We hope all of you that were able to vote enjoyed the experience and convenience. I want to thank Linda Carter who takes care of our clubhouse for her efforts in getting the election officials access on multiple times. We also understand that although we were under the impression that everyone in Wortham Villages would be able to vote at our clubhouse, that was not the case and that some of the residents showed up to vote at the clubhouse and were turned away. We are truly sorry that this occurred. During the election day we found out that the new precinct outline for our neighborhood was rather confusing. There are certain streets that form the outline of the neighborhood, such as Magnolia Leaf, Dogwood Blossom and Harvest Dale, where one side of the street was in our neighborhood Precinct 980 and the other side of the street was in another Precinct 480. We also found out that on the Eldridge side of the neighborhood there are actually three different precincts for different parts of this small area alone (980, 480 and 640). The Board intends to inquire with the Harris County election office if there is any way to adjust these precinct areas so our whole neighborhood is in one, but we do not know if that change would be approved as it was based on redistricting done by the State Legislature. We intend on reviewing this prior to any future elections and notify the neighborhood as best we can, but we would always encourage our residents to check online at Harris County Votes, prior to any election. It is likely that for any elections other than a National Election every four years, that your voting precinct will probably not be at our clubhouse, due to the anticipated turnout by voters.




