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POOL SEASON IS ALMOST HERE!

As a reminder, to enter the community pools, residents must show a Pool ID card validated for 2013 as well as utilize the electronic access device.

Electronic Access Device: If you have a key fob or access card that works for the tennis courts or fitness center, this will also work for the pool facilities. These do not expire so if you have one from any prior year, it is still valid and you do not need anything further. If you have a metal key fob, please check the access by using it at the fitness center. If it doesn't work, you may bring it to the onsite office for an exchange to the new access card.

Pool Cards: If you have a pool card issued by the community, you must have a sticker showing the year "13". If you received a new sticker last year, it may say 12 & 13.

To Receive Validation Stickers, New Cards, or an Electronic Device: Option 1: Visit the onsite office during normal office hours – Monday and Wednesday from 2 - 7 pm and Saturdays from 9 am to 1 pm.

Option 2: Attend one of the scheduled Pool Card Validation Days which are currently scheduled as follows, each at the Eagle Springs Clubhouse by the Athletic Club pool.

April 25 from 6 pm to 9 pm April 27 from 9 am to 4 pm April 30 from 6 pm to 9 pm

- Everyone getting a card must appear in person
- \$2 for each card needed (check and cash only)
- Proof of residency (drivers license or a bill showing ES address) for every ADULT
- To be in good standing (HOA fees paid) with the HOA
- A completed "Pool Card Application Form" which can be found on the website or at the office
- Lease documents if you do not own the home in ES
 I NEED TO VALIDATE AN EXISTING CARD
- Only one family member must be present, but must present all cards
- No Charge / No proof of residency is required
- To be in good standing (HOA fees paid) with the HOA
- A completed "Pool Card Application Form"
- Current lease documents if you do not own the home in ES
 I DON'T HAVE A KEY FOB OR ACCESS CARD
- Only one member of the household must be present
- \$10 each only one per household is required (check and cash only)
- Proof of residency (drivers license or a bill showing the ES address)
- To be in good standing (HOA fees paid) with the HOA
- A completed "Access Card Application Form"
- Lease documents if you do not own the home in ES

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Scouts & Eagle Springs Residents Support **"SOUPER BOWL OF CARING"**

On Saturday, February 2nd, Packs 926 and 912 scouted the Eagle Springs neighborhood looking for food donations that residents had left on their door steps. Youth across America were doing the same participating for the 23rd year in the history of tying "giving" to the Super Bowl weekend in an event called the "Souper Bowl of Caring". In 1990, the first year it started, \$22,000 was raised. Last year more than \$50 million in food and cash was raised across the USA.

Our local packs did their part. They had 42 youth and 35 adults help gather, sort and deliver the food collected in the community. They collected and delivered 935 cans/dry goods weighing approximately 750 pounds to the local food banks here in Humble area.

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A Focus on Healthy Snack Ideas

March is National Nutrition Month. Celebrate by trying out some of these healthy snack ideas:

- Whole grain bagel with melted low fat or non-fat cheese
- Baked tortilla chips and salsa
- Cereal (preferably whole-grain) and low-fat or fat free milk
- Homemade trail mix of wheat or bran Chex or cheerios, pretzels, raisins, and nuts
- Whole wheat toast with butter or margarine and jam
- Baby carrots, broccoli, cauliflower, or celery and yogurt-based dip
- Fruit, including fresh, frozen, canned, or ready-to-eat fruit, such as apples peeled and sliced, oranges cut into sections, cantaloupe and pineapple in bite-sized cubes, or fruit salad
- Fruit shake or smoothie made with frozen fruit and a cup of fat free or low-fat milk or yogurt
- Vegetable soup
- Bean burritos or burrito bites containing canned, fat-free refried beans, low-fat cheese, and salsa on a tortilla roll up and cut into bite-sized pieces
- Tortilla roll-ups: spread chicken breast strips, salsa, and lettuce

on a tortilla. Roll up and cut into bite-sized pieces. Or, leave out the tortilla and roll up the chicken and salsa in the lettuce

- Yogurt, alone, or as a dip or topping for fresh fruit
- Layer fruit, yogurt and grape-nuts in a glass for a parfait
- Nuts
- Peanut butter on graham crackers
- Peanut butter on sliced apple or celery
- · Milkshake made with nonfat or low-fat frozen yogurt
- Sugar-free pudding or Jello cup
- Oatmeal raisin or peanut butter cookies and fat free or low-fat milk
- Zucchini or pumpkin bread
- Low fat Cottage cheese and fruit
- Turkey sandwich on wheat bread
- Granola or cereal bar
