SOCIAL COMMITTEE

ADOPT A SCHOOL COMMITTEE





TEXAS ONE CALL SYSTEM: DIAL "811"

Prior to performing work on your property, call the "Texas One Call System at 811". They will mark the location of the utility lines easement within your property. Remember, damages to any utility lines within your property can affect services to YOU and YOUR neighbor's homes. Thanks for taking time to call before you dig! I am reaching out to the community looking for volunteers to house an international student for this fall semester or school year. 
