Summerwood Pool Season Almost Here!

Your pool committee has been hard at work over the winter months making additions and improvements to all aquatic facilities in the hopes of increasing your enjoyment this summer.

After that, a new shower area was installed at Central. To top it off, we re-surfaced the baby pool at East. Please remember that beginning May 4th the lifeguards will be enforcing the wristband policy.

Summerwood Boy Scouts Trained in First Aid and CPR

Robert Mitchell from Energy Maintenance Services, a Global Pipeline Group ("EMS"), conducted a day long First Aid and CPR training for Boy Scout Troop 1922 at Lakeside United Methodist Church, here in Summerwood, on Saturday, April 6th, 2013. EMS provided five trainers to guide twenty (20) scouts and leaders through to ultimately achieve their Red Cross First Aid and CPR certification. These trainers were all former emergency services personnel, firemen, and/or policemen and are current EMTs.

First Aid -- caring for the ill or injured until professional care arrives -- is one of the most important scouting skills. These Summerwood Scouts successfully completed several mass casualty drills in which there were multiple victims to treat for injuries simultaneously. These mock injuries ranged from minor sprains and cuts to life threatening wounds just as they would in a real life disaster setting. The boys had to perform just as a professional responder would. It was very exciting to see how well they did under pressure.

They also learned how to treat injuries from common hazards found in our natural environment such as poisonous snakes, plants, spiders, water hazards, hypothermia, hyperthermia, burn hazards and more.

The Scouts are very grateful to EMS personnel Robert Mitchell, Terry Pena, Raul Fuentes, Cornealius Wilkins and Duane Moore for their expert training and guidance. We also want to thank our charter organization, Lakeside United Methodist Church, for the use of their facilities.

The Lake Houston area's first single-incision robotic surgery performed at Memorial Hermann Northeast

A surgeon affiliated with Memorial Hermann Northeast Hospital has successfully performed the Lake Houston area's first gallbladder removal through a single small incision in the bellybutton using the *da Vinci®* Si Surgical System. Because it's performed through the navel, the procedure leaves virtually no visible scar.

"This is quite an advancement over traditional surgery," said surgeon Jose Ortega, M.D., "We were able to remove the patient's gallbladder safely through one tiny incision."

Memorial Hermann Northeast was the first Lake Houston-area hospital to offer this version of the *da Vinci*[®] Si robot with the single-site system. The innovation allows procedures to be made using a single incision rather than the three to five previously required by traditional robotic-assisted procedures.

"Memorial Hermann Northeast is proud to make this remarkable technology available to area residents," said Heath Rushing, the hospital's chief operating officer. "These single-site procedures can make patients healthier with little or no scarring, which leads to a faster recovery."

"There is a trend among patients seeking less-invasive techniques, " commented Dr. Ortega. "The *da Vinci®* robot is the breakthrough we were looking for to support our patients."

Surgeons affiliated with Memorial Hermann Northeast are now performing *da Vinci®* robot-assisted procedures in gynecology, urology and general surgery.
