Trustee Position Open for 2014

Nominations are now being accepted for one (1) trustee position open for the Atascocita Community Improvement Association Board (ACIA). The trustee will serve for a three (3) year term, January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2016 the position is open to all ACIA members. Trustees meet monthly on the fourth Monday at 6:00pm.

Those members who desire to run for the board position should prepare a brief resume, five or six lines. The ACIA must expend considerable funds paying contractors to pick up and dispose of green waste (dead tree branches) that were dumped on common areas. Dumping of green waste has also happened on the petroleum pipeline running through the sections located on the south side of FM 1960. Dumping degrades the environment, is an eyesore, and is difficult to clean up. We should all take our obligation to protect the neighborhood environment very seriously.

The trash contractor, Waste Management, will pick up branches that are bundled and less than 4 feet in length. Local business, Dirt Cheap Mulch, will accept branches of any length for a small fee. Prune Trees For Safety


