How to Choose and Install a WordPress Theme (September 16, 2013)

There are thousands of free themes available on wordpress.org, and that doesn't even include all of the premium themes and frameworks that are available, much less the option for creating a custom theme. With all those options in mind, choosing between all of these themes can be bewildering. But it doesn't have to be that way. This month, we will discuss how to make smart choices when picking out a theme for your site. Monthly Leader Meetings will be Monday, October 28th at 9:30am at Cups & Cones and at 6:45pm at St. Luke's church


