TENNIS CARD INFORMATION

Our renovated Tennis Courts are open! If you currently have a tennis card YOU MUST fill out a Tennis Card Registration Form to have THAT card activated (and all HOA fees paid up to date). There is NO FEE for existing tennis cards to be activated when turning in your form. THIS FORM MUST BE FILLED OUT YEARLY, this is to ensure that our current residents in Winchester Country are the ONLY RESIDENTS with access to the tennis courts. If you are requesting a tennis card for the first time or need a replacement card there is a \$10 fee that you must attach to your Tennis Registration Form. You may put your Form with \$10 in the mail slot located at the clubhouse / pool to the left of the gate under the bulletin board. You will be mailed a card that will automatically at that time be activated (providing all fees are up to date). New Forms in 2014

Starting in January, we will update all our card files for the calendar year, so you will need to re-submit your pool and tennis forms to utilize these amenities in 2014. Your homeowners fees must be paid in full and you MUST be a RESIDENT of Winchester Country.

If you are requesting a card for the first time or need a replacement, there is a \$10 fee. If you already have cards, no fee necessary.

Be on the lookout for new 2014 forms in your annual homeowners fee letter. They will also be available in future newsletters, online and at the clubhouse.
