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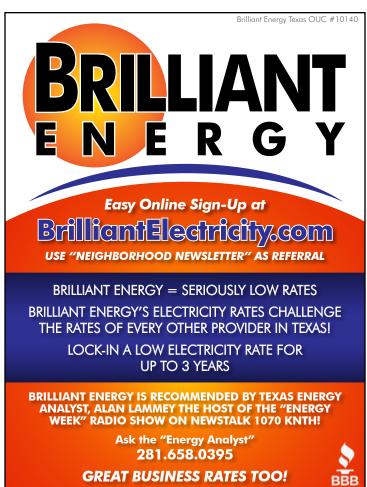

Step: High intensity, low impact movements performed on and off a step platform with risers. Intensity level determined by speed, travel and execution of movement patterns.

Yoga: Designed to enhance vitality and sense of well-being. Focus on flexibility, balance, strength, and posture. Great for stress reduction! **Kickboxing:** Class using gloves & boxing bags. Cardio section uses intensity drills followed by work recovery segments.

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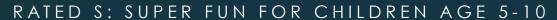
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Happy Easter!
