

## Homework Tips For Parents and Their School Children:

- 1. Know the teachers and what they're looking for. Attend school events, such as parent-teacher conferences, to meet your child's teachers. Ask about their homework policies and how you should be involved.
- 2. Set up a homework-friendly area. Make sure kids have a well-lit place to complete homework. Keep supplies — paper, pencils, glue, scissors — within reach.
- 3. Schedule a regular study time. Some kids work best in the afternoon, following a snack and play period; others may prefer to wait until after dinner.
- 4. Help them make a plan. On heavy homework nights or when there's an especially hefty assignment to tackle, encourage your child break up the work into manageable chunks. Create a work schedule for the night if necessary — and take time for a 15-minute break every hour, if possible.
- 5. Keep distractions to a minimum. This means no TV, loud music, or phone calls. (Occasionally, though, a phone call to a classmate about an assignment can be helpful.)

- 6. Make sure kids do their own work. They won't learn if they don't think for themselves and make their own mistakes. Parents can make suggestions and help with directions. But it's a kid's job to do the learning.
- 7. Be a motivator and monitor. Ask about assignments, quizzes, and tests. Give encouragement, check completed homework, and make yourself available for questions and
- 8. Set a good example. Do your kids ever see you diligently balancing your budget or reading a book? Kids are more likely to follow their parents' examples than their advice.
- 9. Praise their work and efforts. Post an Aced test or art project on the refrigerator. Mention academic achievements to relatives.
- 10. If there are continuing problems with homework, get help. Talk about it with your child's teacher. Some kids have trouble seeing the board and may need glasses; others might need an evaluation for a learning problem or attention disorder.

# **Gardening Tips for September**

September is here and the heat continues. We have been lucky this year and have had enough rain to keep the yards and gardens growing long past what is normal for our summers. However, this does come with several downsides. The moisture and humidity has increased the growth of all fungus.

Mushrooms come up in potted plants and flower beds and slime molds grow on our mulch. Neither of these are really harmful to our lawn and garden, but they are unsightly. Dry weather will cure both these problems but to speed up the process you can spray them with "Consan Triple Action 20" mixed according to directions. This product is an algaecide, fungicide and Bactericide, and will not harm your plants.

Lawn fungus will also be on the increase this year, so keep a close eye on your lawn and either apply a fungicide as a preventative or treat as soon as you see the first signs of damage.

September is the time to give your azaleas the last feeding of the season. Also feed Bougainvillea, Crepe Myrtles and Palms. September is the month to separate any perennials which have



not been separated in the past three years. Cannas and Daylily will benefit from this as well as many bulbs. Now is the time many local nurseries will be receiving Mums. This perennial comes in a wide range of colors and flower shapes. Mum plants from the nursery will bloom earlier than the plants you have established in your garden. Mums are "day length sensitive" plants, and growers will force their plants Into bud by covering the greenhouses with dark shade cloth at a certain time each day.




