# How to Get the Home You Want



## 1. Get Ready

Talk to Your Mortgage Professional about your situation and credit history to determine loan options. It's important to know how much house you can afford based on your down payment and income. A strong letter of pre-approval can really add to your bargaining power.

Meet with Your Real Estate Agent. Discuss your needs and preferences, and establish the best method for your agent to send listings and communicate with you about available properties. ## 2. Shop Smart
