One message from CBONS and Century is they want everyone to know that our club is open to the entire Walden community and they want the Board of Directors and the Walden management team to begin to reach out to the community and get each of you involved in the recreation facilities, activities, events and the fun that we are going to experience here. So, please watch for the newsletters, the announcements, and listen for the voices of those having fun as these changes occur.

The Board of Governors is excited about what we have heard and we expect you will be too. We all look forward to the changes that will happen soon.

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
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APRIL IN HOUSTON
