Our swim-lesson program is level-based and starts beginners as young as three years old for group or private classes. Each level passed is rewarded with color-coded bracelets to keep your child motivated! Swimming Sea Animals also offers "mommy and me" classes and adult swimming lessons. GuardHouston is our lifeguard branch, which certifies and trains some of the best lifeguards in town. All lifeguards are American Red Cross certified in lifeguard training and CPR/first aid. Residents should also call Aquatic Advisors in order to have pool parties scheduled at the community pools. We require one lifeguard for every twenty party attendees (swimmers and non-swimmers) during pool-hour parties. There is a four-guard minimum for parties outside pool hours held at the Summerwood east pool and a threeguard minimum for parties outside pool hours held at the central pool. It's getting hot, and everyone probably has the pools on their minds. Everyone in the pool area over the age of two is required to wear a wristband. The Summerwood pages on www.ciaservices.com offer a variety of information and services, including an easy way to apply for your wristbands in advance.

Once on the site, select Find My Community and choose Summerwood. You will see the Summerwood home page with all the latest news and events, as well as upcoming meetings. Click on Ask.Request.Submit. Under Device Request, click on Ask for Things Here. Select the type of device you are requesting, and you will be able to complete the form online. You can then select which office you would like to pick up your package, or you can have it mailed to you (for an additional fee). Once submitted online, the information is immediately sent electronically to the appropriate personnel, and the device will be prepared for pickup. If payment is required, the device will be released upon payment. You can also apply for other Summerwood items, including electronic fobs/cards and vehicle decals. There are also other services available through www. ciaservices.com, as follows:

Complete a Home Improvement Application: You can electronically complete an application for your next home improvement project! The system will ask you everything needed in order for the committee to make an informed decision. This lessens the chance of a delay due to lack of information. As soon as you submit an application, it will be in the hands of the management company to process to the Architectural Review Committee. Click on Ask.Request.Submit. Then select Home Improvement Request. There you will be told everything that you will need to submit, and as soon as you have gathered your information, you'll be ready to get started.

Pay Your Assessments: Pay your assessments online with a credit card or eCheck! Click Pay Your Assessments and follow the instructions on the screen. There is a convenience fee for credit cards, but eChecks are free! You will need the management company ID (3018), association ID (2070), and your account number. All of the ID numbers are found on the bottom of your statements from CIA Services.

Read and Print Governing Documents: Print or simply review all of the governing documents and publications for your community. Click on Community Documents. There you will see a list of all of the documents and publications available. The files are provided in Adobe PDF format, and you can download a free reader if necessary.

Find Information: Looking for information about Summerwood? Check out Home and Community Information for general information, including amenities, utilities, important phone numbers, and more! Go to News and Events for the latest news and a list of upcoming events and meetings. You will find a list of community volunteers, management personnel, and contractors under Key Personnel. Also, learn about volunteer positions on the Become a Volunteer page.

"April showers bring May flowers. That is what they say." –Anonymous

We have had our fair share of rain showers; however, the flowers are slower to come. This year has brought a significant amount of rain to the Houston area, and the heat is not far behind, which will bring us the beautiful gardens that Summerwood residents are known for. Here are a few additional tips to ensure that your lawn and garden beds are looking their best.

Mowing: Ensure that mowers' blades are raised about three inches high to prevent disease and keep moisture at the roots.

Weeding: To reduce weeds as well as keep plants protected, ensure that the proper one to two inches of mulch are placed in the beds. This will allow for easier weeding.

Fertilizing: Whether flowers or vegetables gardens, ground or container plants, fertilizing will ensure robust blooms and abundant fruit and veggies. Slow-release fertilizer should be applied in June; liquid form is the easiest to apply.

Watering: Even though we've had our fair share of rain, remember to water plants, especially container plants. Deeproot trees and shrubs should be watered to encourage the roots to move deeper into the soil, where they will be less susceptible to moisture changes.

Pests: Not all insects are harmful to our plants, so watch for the beneficial insects. Check in the early morning hours for snails and slugs, and pick them off by hand. Daily checking will be required starting in June to ensure insects don't get the best of our plants.

Not only do we want to take care of our greenery this time of year, but we also want to take care of ourselves. After a long winter and wet spring, we are not use to the movement of gardening. Make sure you stretch your legs and back as well as drink plenty of water to keep hydrated.

We look forward to another beautiful year in Summerwood. Happy gardening!

L. I would like to update my email address. How can I do that?


A: When you log into the community intranet, you will see a link in the login area labeled "view profile." In this area, you can update your email address, change your password, and edit your personal information.




LAKES OF SUMMERWOOD



Many residents have asked for information regarding the distances around the Summerwood lakes. Lake Meredith is the largest lake, with a distance around of 4,803 feet, or 0.91 mile. Lake Anne is the second-largest lake, with a distance around of 3,444 feet, or 0.65 mile. The smallest lake is Lake Ryan (pictured), near the tennis court. The distance around it is 724 feet, or 0.13 mile.




