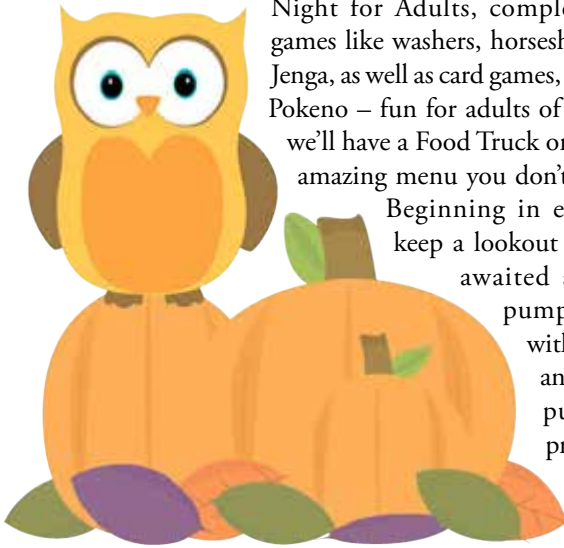
## Fall Festivities and Family Fun
