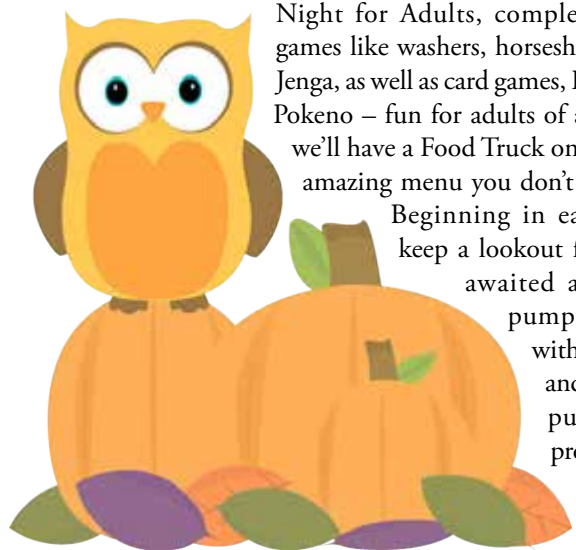
we'll have a Food Truck on hand with an amazing menu you don't want to miss!

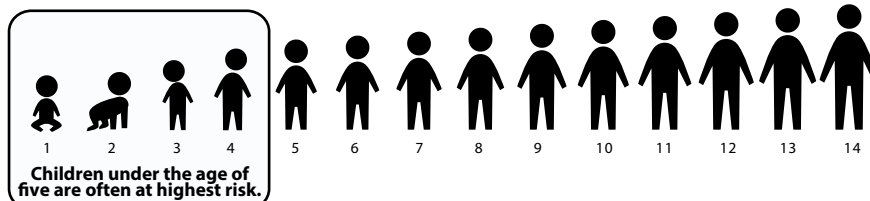

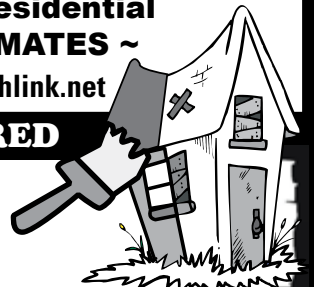
