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## **Neighborhood Committee** and Rep Elections

The Silverlake HOA will hold elections for Neighborhood Committees and Representatives. The HOA is divided into 18 "neighborhoods" (12 residential and 6 commercial), each of which elects a 3 member committee, of which the person receiving the most votes becomes the Neighborhood Representative. The Committee serves a term of 2 years. The Rep's duties include attendance at the Association meetings requiring Representative attendance and casting of the number of eligible votes allotted to the Neighborhood he or she represents for any Association matter or issue requiring a vote by the members. Aside from this, the Rep and Committee positions are what the committee members make of them. 
## ALL PETS OFF YOUR PROPERTY MUST BE ON A LEASH




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
