

The Streets At Night Are Big And Bright, Deep In The Heart Of Jester

The City of Austin is replacing 35,000 high-pressure sodium street lighting fixtures with energy efficient LEDs. The upgrade will help the city save more than \$200,000 per year in energy costs.

Austin Energy is changing out 270 streetlights in Jester Estates from 100-watt high-pressure sodium to 75-watt LED lights. This will increase lighting illumination by 300% and still save 61,000 kilowatt hours per year. They are designed to last up to 60,000 hours, or more than 16 years when on 10 hours a day, while delivering uniform, warm, white light.

Austin is one of only a few cities in the country that has streetlights that are both automated and Dark Sky compliant. At about this time last year, Austin Energy also completed an initial conversion of about 13,100 streetlights to LED with a savings of more than 4 million kilowatt hours annually.
