Winter Holiday Safety

The National Fire Protection Association recommends following a few simple tips to help ensure a happy and fire-safe holiday.

- Be careful with holiday decorations. Choose decorations that are flame resistant or flame retardant.

- Keep lit candles away from decorations and other things that can burn. Two out of five home decoration fires are started by candles. Remember to blow out lit candles when leaving the room or going to bed.

- Some lights are for indoor or outdoor use, but not both.

- Replace any strings of lights with worn or broken cords or loose bulb connections. Read manufacturers' instructions for the number of light strands to connect.
- Use clips, not nails, to hang lights so the cords will not get damaged.
 - Keep decorations away from windows and doors.
- Test your smoke alarms and make sure your family has a home fire escape plan.
 - Keep children and pets away from lit candles.
 - Keep matches and lighters up high in a locked cabinet.
 - Stay in the kitchen when cooking on the stovetop.
- Ask smokers to smoke outside. Remind smokers to keep their smoking materials with them so young children to not touch them.
- Provide large, deep ashtrays for smokers. Wet cigarette butts with water before discarding.






