We hope you had an enjoyable and safe holiday with your family and friends. As 2015 comes to a close, the POA board would like to inform you of the progress we've made concerning the new clubhouse and community area.

The project is moving forward! The board is making headway in attaining financing for the loan. We have spoken to several banks and are planning to choose one soon. Furthermore, we are moving forward on securing design contracts. We anticipate we will be able to choose a preliminary engineer by the end of this month. If all goes well, we hope to break ground in September, at the end of the pool season, and have the project completed by May 2017 – just in time for the next pool season! The board is excited about the projected lower maintenance cost of up-keeping the new facilities. We believe the new community facilities will be both useful and convenient to current residents, as well as attractive to potential new residents.

As the board prepares for our forthcoming new facilities, we are actively trying to reserve capital. Thus, we want residents to know we are aware the fence behind small playground is missing. It was in disrepair for a while, and was a potential hazard; thus, we had it removed. However, we felt it is an unnecessary expense considering construction will be beginning in that area in a few short months.

Similarly, we are aware of the broken picnic table and park bench. We apologize that this leaves a shortage of furnishing in park; however, again, due to trying to reserve as much capital as possible for the new construction, we have decided to not replace these items at this time. When the construction is finished, we want to assure residents that it will include low-maintenance furnishings, which will last long term.

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
