

GREEN TIPS

Caterpillars = Bird Food

I bet many of you have seen the annual appearance of “Little worms falling out of trees”. These are oak leaf roller caterpillars. They are also baby bird food. They appear in spring because this is the time of the year when birds build their nests and raise their young. Insects and caterpillars are high in protein and provide the fast growth necessary to fledge the young. Often I hear of folks that are concerned they will damage their trees. This rarely happens. Instead the eating of caterpillars usually stimulates the trees as well as other plants to put out more leaves and the damage is replaced with new foliage. This assault usually ends by the end of April or early May.

If you are using BT or other pesticides please reconsider. If adult birds pick up infected caterpillars, it endangers the health of their young. So let nature do its thing and just provide lots of larval plants so that birds and butterflies can go through their life cycle and provide us nature lovers with the free display that we enjoy.
