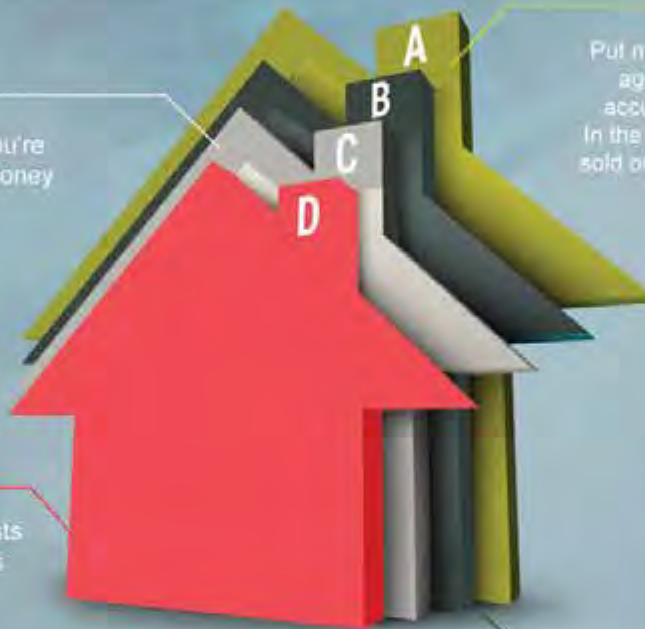

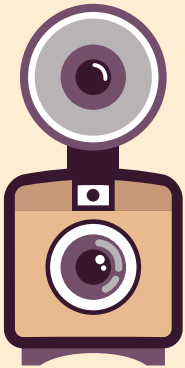
ARTICLE INFO
