

Students attending the national competition were

encouraged to audition for the Music Works Workshop and one of our CyRanch students, Brock Burnett was selected to participate and perform on the MainStage as the lead for National award winning musical, Chrysalis. Students auditioned and one of our CyRanch Comedy Sportz students, Ross Strickland, was selected for the Improv iItensive with a culminating performance. We also had several students audition for colleges with a large number of callbacks increasing opportunities for admissions.


