

## ANNUAL FORE CY-FAIR GOLF TOURNAMENT SET FOR OCTOBER 3

## BENEFITTING THE ADAM J. SKINNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP OF THE CY-FAIR EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

The Cy-Fair Houston Chamber of Commerce invites the community to its 18th annual FORE Cy-Fair Golf Tournament at Blackhorse Golf Club on Monday, October 3.

The tournament benefits the Adam J. Skinner Memorial Scholarship of the Cy-Fair Educational Foundation. A scholarship has been established in his memory and the Chamber has contributed more than \$104,000 to date to the endowment.

Player registration will begin at 9:00 a.m. A putting contest and the opening of the driving range will follow at 10:00 a.m. Shotgun start will be at 11:00 a.m. with the awards, dinner, raffle and silent auction at 4:00 p.m.

## CYPRESS 5K AND PUPPY PARADE

Cypress and Houston area residents can strengthen their families, their bodies, their neighborhood school, and their dogs at a very fun family friendly event this fall. Cypress 5K Fun Run and Puppy Parade benefiting the Performing Arts Department at Spillane Middle School will take place Saturday, November 19th at 9:00 a.m. at Spillane Middle School, 13403 Spillane Woods Blvd.

The event is the school's third annual Fun Run, and will feature a timed run. 




