The Turtles are coming.....

The Alvin ISD Education Foundation will host the 16th Turtle Race on Saturday, February 11, 2017 at National Oak Park in Alvin. The day will start with a fun run at 9 a.m. sponsored by Kelsey Seybold, and the Turtle Race at noon. Community members, parents, students and staff are all encouraged to adopt turtles for the race. All proceeds from the Turtle Race benefit the students and teachers

in the Alvin ISD through Innovative Teaching Grants, campus grants, and scholarships for students, teachers and paraprofessionals. Turtles can be adopted for \$5 by filling out an adoption form, available at all Alvin ISD campuses, the Alvin ISD Central Administration Building, Alvin-Manvel Area Chamber of Commerce, YMCA of Alvin, Alvin Community College and TDEC, Inc, as well as online at www.alvinisd.net/educationfoundation.

The day of the Turtle Race the adopted turtles will be taken to Mustang Bayou and gently dropped in from the bridge along the Tom Blakeney Hike and Bike Trail at National Oak Park in Alvin. The turtles will then "race" down the bayou to the finish line near the Adoue St.

Bridge where they will be "scooped" out and the winners determined. The adopter of the first turtle to cross the finish line will win the first place prize of a travel voucher valued at \$1,500 to a destination

Prior to the Turtle Race, the Foundation will conduct the 5th annual 5K Family Fun Run/Walk and 1K Kids Fun Run/Walk sponsored by Kelsey Seybold. The race will begin at 9 a.m. Individuals

will receive a t-shirt for participating. This year the 5K course has been officially certified and it will be a timed race. The application can be found at signmeup.com.

Booth space is available for groups or individuals to sell or share items, including food vendors. Booths will be set up along the trail by the near the bridge. # Bring the World to Your Child by **Hosting a Foreign Exchange Student**

One life changing way to broaden your child's world view is to volunteer to host a high school foreign exchange student. Foreign exchange programs have been around for almost 100 years, and their mission has always been the same – to educate people about different cultures through person-to-person exchange.

"We welcome host families of all shapes and sizes – families with young children, families with no children, empty nesters whose children have left home, single parents and non-traditional families," says Connie Coutu, regional manager for Ayusa, a nonprofit promoting global learning and leadership through foreign exchange and study abroad opportunities for high school students. "The key requirements for a host family are to provide a safe and nurturing home environment, genuinely love children, and have a desire to learn more about a different culture."

Volunteer host families provide foreign exchange students a nurturing environment, three meals a day and a bedroom (either private or shared with a host sibling of the same gender). Each host family and student is supported by a professionally trained

community representative who works with the family and student for the entire program. All interested host families must pass a criminal background check and a home visit by an exchange organization.

Foreign exchange students come from all over the world including Argentina, China, and France to name a few. All high school foreign exchange students are fully insured, bring their own spending money, and are proficient in English – and all high school exchange programs are regulated by the U.S. Department of State.

Interested host families are required to fill out an application, pass a background check and interview with a local exchange program representative in their homes. Once accepted to a program, host families can view profiles of students to find the right match for their family.







