Crime Prevention Tip

From: Officer Joshua Visi, from the Austin Police Department

I wanted to share some valuable information from one of my patrol counterparts. During the 2nd weekend of March, Patrol responded to burglary of a vehicle call in a southwest Austin neighborhood, where the victim's vehicle was broken into and a gun was stolen. The good news is that Patrol arrested three suspects and recovered the stolen gun. The bad news is patrol officers observed "DOZENS" of vehicles that were unsecured and/or had "perceived" valuables in plain sight. Items ranged from unopened mail packages, backpacks, and other bags that appeared to be full of items. Remember property crime is largely preventable if you remove the "opportunity". Please help us reduce crime and keep your neighborhoods safe by doing your part.


Summer Playdates-Dates are TBD

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
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
