Tree Planting

These days, most homeowners in the Steeplechase neighborhood have well established trees. It is not only pleasing to the eye but also provides shades. Even if it does not shade your house, collectively, it provides a cooling effect in the surrounding area. However, some of these trees are either getting too old, have diseases or have insect larva that bores to the trunk. This weakens the structure and eventually breaks it off causing you to have to chop the whole tree down. So now what?

Well, here're a few tips to watch for. Firstly, you should know where the major roots are because they will eventually rot and if they run close to your house, they might cause you foundation problems. Secondly, if you are thinking of planting a new tree, make sure it's not too close to the house. Depending on tree types, roots usually spread out about 2 to 3 times the diameter of the tree. Also, keep in mind that their roots can damage your sewer lines, water lines, sidewalks and driveways.

Generally speaking, there are two root types, deep taproots or lateral, fibrous roots. Trees with deep taproots send their roots deep within the earth to seek out water and nutrients. Trees with fibrous, lateral roots spread their roots horizontally near the soil surface to absorb rain runoff from the tree's canopy. These lateral roots can grow quite large and heave up heavy cement such as sidewalks.

So, plan well when planting a new tree and ask for expert advice if you are not sure what to choose or the best location to plant it. Personally, I would think about the sunrise and sunset, then how it would be the view from the front of the house or from the backyard, and also, I would check if it will be near to the pavement, sewer or water lines and power lines.

Homes Along the Bayou Trail

The Steeplechase residents that line the bayou trail should note that Chaparral Management will begin to inspect for deed restriction violations visible from the trail as this is a public walking area.

This inspection is the same as the deed restriction inspection along Eldridge Parkway as well as Steepleway Blvd where homes back up to the greenbelt areas, the walkway along Eldridge or a public street.

Please take note as these inspections will look for visible violations such as leaning or damaged fencing, yard trash tossed over the property fence or dumped onto the maintained trail area.

- Must have a swim wristband at all times while at the pool. 1.
- 2. Must be a resident member and/or guest of a resident member who is present at the pool.
- Must be current on all Annual Assessments to the Steeplechase 3. Community Improvement Association (SCIA) or on an approved payment plan.
- 4. Must comply with pool rules and policies.
- 5. Swim wristband not required for children two (2) years of age or younger.
- 6. Tenants must supply a copy of their rental lease with the owner of the property.
- Children under thirteen (13) years of age must be accompanied 7. by an adult.

For admission to the pool, a 2017 pool wristband will be required. Please complete the enclosed Registration Form and bring it to the Steeplechase Pool on the following days that have been set aside for pool registration by your Board of Directors. 2017 POOL RULES

- 1. SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- 2. THIS FACILITY IS FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF RESIDENTS AND GUESTS OF THE STEEPLECHASE COMMUNITY.
- 3. YOU MUST HAVE A VALID STEEPLECHASE POOL WRISTBAND TO USE THE FACILITY. Guests within the pool area must be accompanied at all times by a resident member of the community.
- 4. ALL TRESPASSERS WILL BE PROSECUTED.
- 5. PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SUPERVISION OF THEIR CHILDREN.
- 6. NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 13 YEARS IS PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA WITHOUT THE SUPERVISION OF AN ADULT, EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER. CHILDREN 13 AND UP MUST BE ABLE TO SWIM ACROSS THE DEEP END OF THE POOL IN ORDER TO BE AT THE POOL UNACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.
- 7. NO SWIMMING WITHOUT A LIFE GUARD ON DUTY.
- 8. Children are not permitted in the adult pool area or the hot tub.
- 9. NO running or rough play. Diving is only allowed in designated areas.
- 10. NO glass containers in or around the pool area.
- 11. NO consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed in the pool area.
- 12. NO smoking in or around the pool area. This is a non-smoking facility.
- 13. NO pets allowed in the pool area.
- 14. NO cutoff jeans NO disposable baby diapers. Infants must wear swim diapers at all times.
- 15. NO loud music or abusive language.
- 16. NO skates, skate boards, or bikes in the pool area.
- 17. NO eating or drinking in the pool.
- Pool will be closed with the first sound of thunder until thirty (30) minutes after the last sound of thunder. Closure shall be the discretion of Life Guards on duty.
- 19. Pool will be closed to all swimmers once every hour for 10 minutes for a lifeguard safety break.
- 20. All swimmers must be cleared from the pool during the administration of serious first aid and during sessions as may be called by the Life Guard from time to time.
- 21. Failure to follow rules may result in immediate removal from the pool area and/or possible suspension from the pool for an extended period of time.
