# FINGER LICKING GOOD BBQ CHICKEN WINGS



#### Ingredients

cup flour
 tsp kosher salt
 tsp paprika
 chicken wings or drumettes
 cup BBQ Sauce

tsp chili powder
 tsp freshly ground black pepper
 tsp garlic powder
 tbsp Mayonnaise
 up Honey

#### Instructions

- 1. Preheat Oven to 425F
- 2. In a large bowl, combine flour, chili powder, salt, pepper, paprika, and garlic powder set aside.
- 3. In another large bowl, combine BBQ sauce and honey set aside.
- 4. Lightly coat wings with mayonnaise and then drop a few at a time into prepared flour mix to coat, shaking off any excess.
- 5. Place the floured wings onto a parchment paper lined baking sheet and spread them out in a single layer.
- 6. Bake for 23 mins then flip them over.
- 7. Bake for an additional 23 mins, until skin is crispy and golden brown then remove from oven.
- 8. Preheat oven to 500F
- 9. Drop the wings into the large bowl with BBQ Sauce and Honey mix around a few at a time to coat evenly then replace back onto baking sheet, spreading them into a single layer.
- 10. Bake for an additional 8 to 10 mins, until sauce is bubbly and caramelized. Cool then serve!
