# Neighborhood Committee & Representative Elections

The Silverlake HOA will hold elections for Neighborhood Committees and Representatives in December. The Committee serves a term of 2 years. Aside from this, the Representative and Committee positions are what the committee members decide can benefit their neighborhood. 


# Exterior Home Improvements or Modifications


When you are considering an improvement or modification to the exterior of your home be sure to obtain an Architectural Review Committee (ARC) approval form located under Legal Documents on the Silverlake website at (www.silverlakehoa.com). The instructions are thorough and specific. For example, when replacing a fence, provide the height, materials and show the placement of the fence on the survey of your property. You may refer to the guidelines for specific height, materials, finish, construction, and colors to clarify. Your contractor may not be aware of the restrictions so it is best to research the requirements before you begin. Also, take a before and after picture to assure that the structure has been replaced in the original form. Keep in mind that consistency is a major goal in each neighborhood so your new fence should replicate the original fence without any deviation.
