



# Coffee-Chocolate Chip Cookies

#### **INGREDIENTS**

1 ½ cups flour

1/4 tsp baking soda

34 cup butter softened

3/4 cup sugar

½ cup brown sugar

3 tbsp cool strong brewed coffee

1 egg

1 tsp vanilla

2 pkgs (8 ozs.) semi sweet chocolate, chopped

1 ½ cups chopped walnuts

### **DIRECTIONS**

Heat oven to 325 degrees.

Combine flour and baking soda.

Beat sugars & butter until light & fluffy.

Blend in coffee, egg & vanilla.

Gladually beat in flour mixture until well blended.

Stir in chopped nuts & chocolate. Refrigerate 30 mins.

Roll dough into 60 x 1" balls, place on cookie sheet 2" apart. Bake 10-12 mins. Enjoy!
