The clubhouse facility officially reopened at 6:00 pm on May 4th with a ribbon cutting by Carlon Thorpe and Gary Fehsenfeld. Over 250 people joined the festivities and it was a fabulous party.

The Board would like to extend a special thanks to Gary and Carlon for their leadership in the rebuild. They also thank Stephanie Leggett for her assistance to Carlon and Gary especially in the sound dampening panels in the flex room.

Several commonly asked questions/comments about the rebuild are shown below:

1. The furniture looks the same. Is it from before the flood? Yes, because the upholstery furniture did not have any skirts, only the legs got wet. We were able to have the legs refinished as needed on the solid wood items and the upholstery furniture. We also were able to adequately clean the main rug in the center of the room, but the round rug near the front and the decorative trees near the back windows were damaged beyond repair and were replaced.

2. The workout equipment looks the same. Is it original? No. All the workout equipment is brand new. Electronics and water don't mix well. We also replaced all the weights, balls and mats. The mats were chosen based on feedback from the LOE user survey. Heavier weights were also added based on the survey. A new rubber floor was selected to improve durability and looks.

3. How much of the clubhouse was re-done? Almost everything below 4' except the tile floor is new including all new cabinetry, new bath wall tile, new sheetrock, new molding, new electric outlets, etc.

4. I love the big new TV in the flex room. Can I meet friends up there and watch a big game? The flex room is

available on a first come first serve basis during normal operating hours at no cost. If you want to reserve the flex room for a private party the cost is \$50 and the time can be extended beyond normal hours.

5. Now that you have a giant big screen and projector in the main room, will we have more functions? Yes. We anticipate hosting major sporting events, movie nights, etc. If you would like to be involved in planning events, contact Creative Management to be added to the Community Committee.

6. The pool baths look fantastic! I feel like I'm at a spa. What is the floor in there? It is called a lime coat that is designed to go on pool decks or wet areas. It is not slippery. We choose to have it installed in a tile pattern for appearance.

The major upgrades installed as part of the rebuild include:

- Blinds on all lower west facing windows for sun reduction.
- Additional insulation between main clubhouse room
- and workout room to reduce sound transference.
- Power Boosted Wi-Fi network throughout inside and outside of facility

Flex Room

• 65" Smart TV with capability of viewing TV stations, internet streaming or playing personal DVD's from existing DVD player in cabinet.

- Acoustic panels on walls for sound absorption
- Six new 3x8 folding tables

Lake Bulkhead Repair Project

Harris County MUD 341 and the Lakes on Eldridge Community Association Board of Directors are pleased to announce a major project to repair the concrete bulkheads around our lakes. This project is similar to the one done in August of 2014. Construction as of early May is approximately 70% complete and is expected to be completed by the end of May.

Different repair methods will be used depending on the condition of the specific bulkhead. The smaller cracks will be sealed with a flexible grout material. In other areas with larger cracks, tiebacks to wooden posts will be installed behind the wall with a metal rod fastened to the water side of the bulkhead to prevent further shifting. There are a few other areas where small sink holes behind the bulkheads have developed that will be filled. There are other locations that will be regraded to facilitate rainwater drainage.

No fish or wildlife should be impacted by this project. All access to the proposed work areas will be from residential streets and the work will occur within the lake reserve areas (public areas between lot line and lake edge). No areas of residential lots will be used for access, staging, or work areas at any time. The amount of time the onsite contractor, SafeFlow, will be working in any one area should be between 1-3 days.

This work is being financed by Harris County Mud 341. Benchmark Engineering will be providing project management. If you have any questions, please contact Brian Chovanec at bchovanec@benchmarkengr.net

Also No Glass on the pool deck.

Yard Crews - whether you do your own yard work or hire it out, please make sure that no grass clippings, leaves, pine needles or other yard debris is left in the street or blown or swept into the storm sewer inlets.

Community Visitors and Service Providers - all non-residents must enter the community at the main entry on N. Eldridge Parkway and register with the guardhouse in the Visitor Lane. No exceptions.

LOE Windshield Decals - All residents must have a LOE windshield decal displayed on their vehicle to enter in the resident lane. HARVEY, THE FLOOD THAT DESTROYED HOUSTON AND OUR HOME IN LAKES ON ELDRIDGE

It is hard to believe that it has been 9 months since Harvey hit and there are homes still under construction. We wanted to share our pets' experiences during this trying time. The night before we flooded out our parents were very nervous and anxious. We saw them move furniture upstairs. Our pets could sense the stress. Our cat had a urine infection but we could not take him to the vet that day. It was hard to sleep that night. There was continuous tornado warnings. We were terrified. The next morning we woke up to the flood. I remember looking out the window and seeing a river with a canoe and two dogs in it that was being pulled by his owner. Our moms were having panic attacks trying to get us ready to go. We each took a back pack with only essentials and some clothes. We had to take enough pet food to last a few days. We missed the first boat because we could not find our cat, Valentino. He was hiding under the bed terrified. A second boat, with a young couple from San Antonio, came to rescue us. We were their first rescue!!! They drove from San Antonio to help. In fact, people from all over the country came to volunteer in any way needed. The volunteer helped us put Valentino in a crate and Alex on his leash. Alex, our golden was so excited. He thought this was an amazing adventure. In total we had 2 cats, 3 dogs, 4 kids and 7 adults in one boat. This included Rhea and Rohan's grandfather who was just rescued from his home in Charleston Colony which is near us. It was a circus. Mary's cat was calm. Sadie their Old English Sheep dog was thrilled. Alex, the Golden Retriever, was going crazy and charging Sadie, the Sheep dog. Isabella's dog, Bare, was nervous and vomited. Valentino the Ragdoll was crying. Talk about an adventure we will never forget! When we got out we were all relieved and thanked the rescuers. We were very lucky that our pets survived. Other pets in Houston were not as lucky. Many were displaced from their families and others did not make it. All of our houses has completed reconstruction but others in our neighborhood are still in progress. This experience has brought us closer together. This concludes the adventures of Rohan, Matteo, Rhea and Isabella.




