## LTlov Invests \$53,488 dollars in Annual Grants and Program Funding for 2018

Since 2009, LTlov has distributed grants to local non-profits who work in the Lake Travis community and are actively engaged in helping residents overcome limiting circumstances. The money used to fund these much-needed grants comes from a diverse list of donors including individuals, corporations and foundations who share LTlov's vision and trust both their organizational efficiency and their understanding of local needs. This year, LTlov funded grants totaling \$26,448 dollars to 10 organizations. In addition, LTlov also reserved funding in the amount of \$27,040 dollars for the College Scholarships program, Green Santa program and School Supplies' Project Supply Pack program.
