# **Removal of Tree Stakes**

Staking a new tree gives the root system a chance to establish itself in the soil and provide the tree with a strong anchor. But, the stakes are not meant to be permanent and should be removed to benefit further growth and strengthening of the tree. In general, the tree should not need the support for more than six months or a year, or after one growing season. After that, stakes left too long can hinder development. Stakes and wires are also unsightly and over time become increasingly difficult to remove.

# WHAT'S IN SEASON AT THE WILDFLOWER CENTER?

Here's what's likely to be blooming, fruiting or setting seed in Central Texas this time of year. Look for these native plants around town, at the Wildflower Center and perhaps in your own backyard!

#### **COMMON BUTTONBUSH** (CEPHALANTHUS OCCIDENTALIS)

Talk about haute couture! The globe-shaped blooms on Cephalanthus occidentalis really could double as buttons on a fancy dress or blazer — or even as some killer "Mad Men"-era earrings. This perennial's flowers look like other spiffy things, too: namely, fireworks! It's no coincidence that we featured buttonbush in July — maybe that's why it blooms then too (though this shrub's firework show can run from June through August). Its white or sometimes pale pink flowers turn into attractive reddish fruits that are popular with birds, while butterflies and bees are drawn to buttonbush nectar. Plant them in moist-to-wet soil near your garden's water feature and let the fashion show begin!

#### **FLAME ACANTHUS** (ANISACANTHUS QUADRIFIDUS VAR.WRIGHTII)

This is going to sound nerdy, but bear with us: We have a hard time not thinking of a certain mystical creature called a "flame atronach" (from a popular video game) when we encounter flame acanthus. Let's run through a comparison: Flame atronachs float above the ground and leave behind a trail of fire. Yep, if you count brilliant red-orange petals on slender stems as trails of fire (we do!). They prefer casting spells to engaging in physical combat — check. When idle, they do spins and backflips. Sure, if you count hummingbirds and butterflies as the acrobats. Bonus: Drought-tolerant Anisacanthus quadrifidus var. wrightii (though truly a Southwest Texas species) is super versatile, thriving in everything from containers to rocky, calcareous soil and heavy Houston clay. How does it do it? Clearly, the answer is magic.

# **Spider Mites**

It's hot. It's dry. It's time for spider mites. Spider mites are very small to microscopic in size and depending on how good your eyesight is, you may not be able to see them without a good hand lens or microscope.

While spider mites are not insects- they are arachnids and more closely related to spiders than insects- they are pests in the landscape. Most spider mites produce a webbing around their colony. It starts on the underside of leaves and will expand out as the population increases.

Feeding can cause leaves to discolor, creating a speckled appearance on foliage. With severe infestations, leaves discolor to a silver or bronze color and leaves may drop from the plant. While mites feed on the underside of leaves, damage is more apparent on the tops.

Spider mites lay their eggs along the leaf vein during the growing season. Eggs are round and large in size when compared to adult mites. Some species of spider mites peak during warmer months of the year while others become more active in the cooler months of the year. The mites are able to develop more quickly when temperatures are warmer, with some spider mites going from egg to adult in less than 1 week. Spider mites thrive in dry conditions while their natural enemies require more humid



conditions. Dry conditions allow spider mite populations to grow with little predation or parasitism that would help to keep the population at an acceptable level.

There are many predatory arthropods that feed on spider mites. Some of these include predatory mites, spider mite destroyers (a type of ladybug), minute pirate bugs, big-eyed bugs, and predatory thrips. Proper watering of plants may help to reduce spider mite outbreaks as it can reduce stress brought on by drought. Using strong jets of water directed on plants can also help to dislodge spider mites. Miticides or acaricides can be used to manage spider mite outbreaks. Look for active ingredients such as horticultural oils (watch temperature when you use oils), insecticidal soaps, spinosad, abamectin, bifenthrin, dimethoate, or acephate.
