

Friendly Reminders

Please make sure to keep your shrubs trimmed up so that your property address is visible. The City of Austin's ordinance states that the address must be "visible from the street."

Why is this necessary?

Firefighters, emergency vehicles, and personnel may need to find your home quickly should an emergency occur. It is difficult for emergency vehicles, utility trucks, and postal and delivery trucks to find homes and businesses with address numbers that are not properly posted.

The City of Austin's ordinance states that the address must be "visible from the street."

Please remove t-posts and wire surrounding trees if they are no longer being used to support the tree.

Property owners are responsible for maintaining their trees and all other vegetation to the edge of the street. To ensure ease of mobility and safety for all Austin residents, it is important to keep these areas free of obstructions. Streets, sidewalks, and other public rights of way are for everyone's use. Property owners are responsible for their private trees and all other vegetation in the public right-of-way next to their property. Overgrown vegetation is a safety hazard and limits the use of sidewalks and streets. It further threatens public safety when vegetation blocks the view of traffic signs, signals, vehicles, or cyclists. Trimming vegetation and caring for your trees are effective ways residents can enhance neighborhood safety.

Prune your trees and trim or remove any vegetation that obstructs or grows into sidewalks and streets. Limbs and vegetation must be trimmed back from the edge of and at least 8 feet above sidewalk. Limbs and vegetation must be trimmed back from the curbline (edge of street) and at least 14 feet above the street.


