Motorized Vehicles in the Park – BIG NO!!!

We have received a report that a child, estimated to be about 10-12 years old, rode a motorized bike or some type of ATV through the Community Park and into the woods. We do not know whether an adult was with the child. Parents – please note that MOTORIZED RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ARE NOT ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN THE COMMUNITY PARK. It doesn't matter whether an adult or child is riding the vehicle or whether the child is accompanied by an adult. They are noisy, dangerous to others in the Park, and can start a wildfire in our woodland area.

Finally, August is back to school month for many students. Please take extra care to watch out for students during the morning and late afternoon hours as they begin travel to and from school.


