### **WCA SERVICE GUIDELINES**

Residential Garbage Collection Guidelines

- Please have waste ready for collection no later than 7 a.m.
- Refuse must be in bags or cans, weighing no more than 40 pounds.
- Tree branches, brush, shrubs, and fencing must be tied in bundles, weighing no more than 40 pounds, and being no longer than 4 feet in length.
- Branches may be no wider than 3 inches in diameter to avoid damaging equipment.
- Per Federal Law, refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioning units must be drained of all Freon and have an accompanying bill verifying Freon has been drained
- ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED: dirt, rocks, bricks, concrete, tires, batteries, motor oil, cooking oil, waste generated by a private contractor, hazardous/toxic chemicals or material, construction material, no more than 1 room of carpeting, bundled and

- less than 40 pounds. Items not collected will be tagged explaining reason for noncollection.
- For communities receiving backdoor service, please note only household waste will be collected away from the curb unless otherwise stated. Yard waste, heavy trash, and recycle bins/carts must be placed at the curb for collection.

Recycle Collection Guidelines

The following items are accepted in our curbside recycling program:

Paper: Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, Junk Mail, Envelopes, Office Paper, Construction Paper, Colored Paper, Folders, Paper Bags, Phone Books, Holiday Cards and Greeting Cards

Cardboard: Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Paperboard Boxes (cereal, soda/ beer, egg, shoe boxes)



NATIONAL NIGHT OUT began in 1984 to promote involvement in crime prevention activities, policecommunity partnerships, and neighborhood camaraderie, as well as to send a message to criminals that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.

Crime Stoppers of Houston is proud to support all of our communities on NATIONAL NIGHT OUT.



### Did you know?

- Every 15 seconds a burglary occurs, with the average dollar loss being \$2,251.
- Homes without security systems are up to 300% more likely to be broken into.
- Most break-in occur during the day when you are at work.
- 95% of burglars surveyed would run if they met a large, unwelcoming dog face-to-face.
- Your local law enforcement department provides home security checks.
- Getting to know your neighbors is a great defense to keep your neighborhood safe.
- A neighborhood with mowed lawns, flowers, and freshly painted homes looks like it's cared for, and this alone can help deter crime.



#### **Tips for Parents:**

- Know the location of your children. Create a system of communication for knowing where they are or when they reach their destination.
- Set limits on where they can and cannot go in the neighborhood. Consider potential dangers such as busy roads, abandoned houses, railroad tracks, registered sex offenders, etc.
- Familiarize your child with the neighborhood. Show them safe places they can go if they need help such as a neighbor's home, the fire station, police station, trusted stores or business offices.
- · Be sure your child has memorized your home address and phone number along with the phone number of another trusted adult.
- Remind your child to "check first" before they leave the house.

### **KEEP YOUR HOME SAFE:** Prevention is key!

Most neighborhood crimes that occur are crimes of opportunity. Unlocked cars and easy access to your home are a burglar's dream. We cannot take for granted how safe we feel in our homes and community. Anything from running a guick errand and leaving your purse or briefcase in the car, forgetting to turn on your alarm or forgetting to lock your windows could put you at risk.

- Entrust a neighbor or a friend who lives close by with an extra key to your home in case of emergencies. It is not recommended to hide a key around your home.
- Keep shrubbery trimmed away from windows. It will add to your curb appeal and won't allow someone to hide. Maintain outdoor lighting and landscaping.
- Install security cameras and make a habit of using your alarm and locking windows and doors, including interior doors to an attached garage.
- Use timers on lamps in your home; it will appear as someone is home and will provide lighting if you arrive home after dark.
- Postpone your social media travel updates until you return. Updating in real-time alerts others of an empty house.
- Have packages delivered to an alternate address such as a work address if you are not going to be home during a delivery.
- Alert your local law enforcement department if you plan to be away from your home for an extended period of time.

### Do Something Tips

- ✓ Being aware of your neighbors' habits can assist in noticing if something does not seem right.
- ✓ Work together with your neighbors by looking out for suspicious and/or unusual behavior in the neighborhood.
- ✓ Create an email chain for your street/neighborhood to help keep the neighborhood abreast of safety tips and crime trends.
- ✓ Get outside and be visible by hosting block parties, going for walks, playing in the front yard to show potential criminals that you live in a tight knit community where neighbors look out for one another.
- ✓ If something seems questionable or to report suspicious activity, call the non-emergency line of your local police.
- ✓ Don't enter your home if doors or windows are open that you don't recall leaving open. Call the police from a safe distance.
- ✓ Call your neighbor if you see a service vehivle at their house while they are gone.
