## LABOR DAY: WHAT IT MEANS

Labor Day, the first Monday in September, is a creation of the labor movement and is dedicated to the social and economic achievements of American workers. It constitutes a yearly national tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity, and wellbeing of our country.

The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. The Central Labor Union held its second Labor Day holiday just a year later, on September 5, 1883.

In 1884 the first Monday in September was selected as the holiday, as originally proposed, and the Central Labor Union urged similar organizations in other cities to follow the example of New York and celebrate a "workingmen's holiday" on that date. The idea spread with the growth of labor organizations, and in 1885 Labor Day was celebrated in many industrial centers of the country.





## **CYBERBULLYING IS REAL**



Cyberbullying can occur through SMS, Text, and apps, or online in social media, forums, or gaming where people can view, participate in, or share content. Cyberbullying includes sending, posting, or sharing negative, harmful, false, or mean content about someone else. It can include sharing personal or private information about someone else causing embarrassment or humiliation.

#### Bullying Laws in Texas Senate Bill 179, also known as David's Law.

#### Cyberbullying Comes in Many Forms

Cyberbullying has been linked to the death of teenagers who committed suicide after being subjected to embarrassing and cruel posts on social media websites. Emails, text messages, comments left on social media sites such as Facebook and fake web pages are just some of the methods used by those seeking to stalk, threaten and harass other people. Our children and teens are particularly vulnerable to acts of cyberbullying.

Examples of specific acts of cyberbullying include:

- Sending text messages that are cruel, mean or hurtful.
- Using social media and emails to spread lies and rumors about someone.
- Creating fake websites or social media pages under the name of the victim designed to cause embarrassment or humiliation.

#### Helpful tips

- Documentation
- Contact your local police department and file a report.
- Put a STOP to bullying!
