

Assessment Center is a spinoff of Black Tie Boxing, a professional charity boxing match hosted by Benjamin Berg and Lou Savarese in February 2017. More than 20 amateur boxers, who work in the Houston energy industry as commodity traders, brokers and executives by day, have been recruited to fight in this exclusive, one-

of-a-kind charity event. Before they battle it out for a good cause in September, the boxers will endure extensive training under the supervision and coaching of Former Heavyweight Boxing Champion, Lou Savarese.
