Spicewood Community Alliance



Spicewood Community Alliance is a non-political, non-profit group to promote and encourage smart/intelligent business and residential growth within the Spicewood area. Spicewood Community Alliance reaches out to community and area resources to provide educational research and resources to the community in an effort to

help and promote educated decision/solution making over knee jerk reactions.

Spicewood Community Alliance recently coordinated with Spicewood Environmental Protection Alliance, Double Horn Creek, Spicewood Trails, Texas Environmental Protection Coalition and area residents to have a rally to drive awareness and protest against the appearance of government rubber stamping a new proposal for a Rock Quarry/Rock Crushing plant. In addition to the protesting the effort handed out information on the dangers of the possible cancer causing dust, environmental and safety hazards. The new Spicewood Quarry and Rock Crusher is surprisingly planned to be placed on approximately 290 acre tract nestled tightly between two major residential neighborhoods - backing up the Heavily industrial business to numerous existing homes. The current Texas governor (Gregg Abbott) appears to be turning a deft ear to residents attempt to contact him with regard to health, environmental or direct resident concerns; In what was explained by the Govender's' office as an effort to promote a Pro-business tempo throughout Texas. Unofficial comments made by Abbots' offices were that this Pro-business approach will allow business to self-manage any health/welfare or development issues; other rumblings within the Abbott and Texas business backed PACs indicate a desire to over-turn existing laws or push forward new laws that block the ability of communities to limit any type of business regardless of possible health or welfare issue.

Spicewood Community Alliance also held a public meeting on September 23, 2018 @ Spicewood Elementary; to help educate the Spicewood community on options to manage the current appearance of unregulated growth. In addition to the growth of the community the group discussed Texas Highway 71 expansion plans with leading input from Joe Don Dockery, Burnet County Commissioner, on a schedule, timeframe and areas for the construction. Additional possible meetings were discussed before the current planned follow-up meeting with Thomas Ranch development (tentatively planned in January 2019). Spicewood Community Alliance is on Facebook and has a website.



Daughter of a Daughter of a Queen by Sarah Bird Popular cultural education program features bestselling, award-winning author



Now entering its twelfth year, LAKE TRAVIS READS 2019 will feature the new book by acclaimed Austin author Sarah Bird, Daughter of a Daughter of a Queen. The historical novel tells the story of Cathy Williams, the only female soldier to serve with the Buffalo Soldiers, based on the scant historical records that still exist. "I am a daughter of a daughter of a queen

and my mama never let me forget it," Cathy tells the reader in the first line of the book. Her grandmother was a warrior queen in Africa, and Cathy never sees herself as a slave but rather as a captive. She grew up in slavery on a Missouri plantation before the Union army took her away to work as a cook. Later she disguised herself as a man named William Cathay and joined the storied Buffalo Soldiers, African-Americans in the U.S. Army who protected settlers and fought off Native Americans after the Civil War ended.

"Sarah Bird takes a few scant lines from history–fragments, really, the barest of bones that have come down to us of Cathy Williams, slave, freedwoman, U.S. Calvary trooper–and spins from them this magnificent imagining of a flesh-and-blood, heart-and-soul woman who fears and loves and wants and hurts just as fiercely as any of us. This wonderful novel is as rich in the telling as Thomas Berger's Little Big Man and Larry McMurtry's Lonesome Dove, but Bird is breaking new ground, staking out a whole different territory. Cathy Williams, a black woman in history; what's been lost to time and neglect is surely regained in good measure by this brilliant, powerful novel." —Ben Fountain, author of Billy Lynn's Long Halftime Walk.

Bird is well-known to Austin audiences as a delightful speaker in addition to being a prolific author. She is the author of ten novels, including The Gap Year, Above the East China Sea, and The Yokota Officers Club, as well as 2016's A Love Letter to Texas Women, her

hilarious valentine to Texas women she has known. The community is invited to hear Bird speak at the 2019 LAKE TRAVIS READS "Evening with the Author" on Tuesday, February 5, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at the Lake Travis Community Library, located at 1938 Lohmans Crossing in Lakeway. The event is free and open to the public. Copies of the book will be available for purchase and signing.

LAKE TRAVIS READS is a "One Book, One Community" program co-sponsored by Bee Cave Public Library, Lake Travis Community Library, and Spicewood Community Library that encourages the community to read the featured title and then meet the author at a special evening event. Lakeway/ Lake Travis Rotary Club Changes Children's Lives with Help from the Steel Magnolia Shop

During the last fifty years medicine has made advances that would have not been possible before the advent of technology. Local Rotarians have experienced this first hand as they collaborate with Baylor College of Medicine and Steel Magnolias, a local retailer, to address the need for inexpensive prosthetic limbs for children.

In 2014 local Rotarians were in Tanzania to collaborate with a Tanzania Rotary Club on the drilling of a clean water well. While there, the group visited the Kilimanjaro Christian Medical Center. After seeing rooms full of crippled children waiting for help that seldom came, the Rotarians from Lakeway decided there had to be better way. Returning home the club established the 3 D Limb project.

There is a pressing need for artificial limbs through the world! Currently limbs made in the conventional way are expensive. They may take weeks to develop. By working with Trifusion materials development specialist and Baylor College of Medicine the local Rotary Club has been instrumental in changing that! Today, an artificial socket for a prothesis can be printed in as few as four hours. The 3 D printed socket may cost as little as \$100 compared to several hunded dollars for a conventional socket and are made on the same day the child is seen. Clubs in countries such as Sri Lanka, Indian and South America saw a prototype of the 3 D Printed socket at the Rotary International convention in spring of 2018 and are exploring ways to join the Rotary Club's efforts. Another Rotary Club in Pennsylvania is working with the Shriners Hospital to provide limbs for children from Tanzania. The club covers costs associated wth the hospital stay while Shriners Hospital provides medical care without charge. Rotarians all over the world are hoping to get involved with amazing project.

All of this work comes with a cost! The local Rotary club has covered the cost of travel to Tanzania for club members, paid for the room and board of the family staying with the child and has covered the cost of surgery needed in order to fit a child with an artificial limb. Steel Magnolia, a charming shop with an "old world" flavor has stepped up to assist Lakeway/Lake Travis Rotary Club in their efforts to provide help for children with missing limbs. During the month of December the shop will donate 10% of its profit to the Rotary 3 D printed limb project. As residents of Lakeway and the surrounding area shop for Christmas gifts or other special occasion items, everyone is encouraged to stop by and take a look at what shopping with a purpose can mean to a crippled child.
