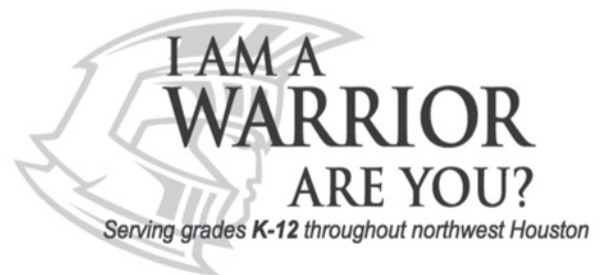
CYPRESS AREA FOOD PANTRY New Days And Times

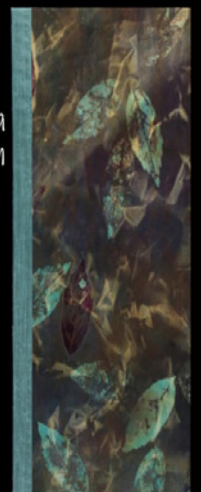
