## **Tree Planting Guide**

When trees grow and extend into power lines, they can cause power outages and safety hazards for you and your neighbors. Prevent these problems by planting the "right tree in the right place," and you won't have to worry about trimming or removing your trees once they grow.

- Fun kids love to play, climb and swing on a tree.
- Wildlife provide a habitat for birds and other animals.

But not every tree is right for you and your yard. Follow the steps below to ensure you have a tree that meets your needs, fits your space and doesn't create problems with nearby power lines.

#### **Steps Before Planting**

- 1. Determine Available Space
- 2. Identify nearby power lines and their type:
- Distribution lines need 10 feet of clearance from vegetation.
- Transmission lines mean no trees inside the Right-of-Way and no tall trees nearby.
- Service drops should never have trees planted beneath them.
- 4. Also look for nearby electrical equipment, like pad mount transformers or smart meters. Don't plant trees, shrubs, plants or other vegetation where it can damage equipment or interfere with CenterPoint Energy's ability to access it.
  - 5. Choose a Tree
- 6. Knowing your space limitations, determine what tree species you want to plant.
  - Distribution-line-friendly, low-growing trees.
  - Transmission-corridor-friendly, low-growing vegetation.
  - The Texas Forest Service Tree Planting Guide helps you find the right tree for your property.
  - 7. Call Before You Dig
- 8. Homeowners must call 811 before digging to avoid hitting underground utility lines.


