TIRR Memorial Hermann Becomes First Houston Partner of the U.S. Department of State Global Sports Mentoring Program: Sport for Community

Welcomes international leader and delegate from the United Arab Emirates

TIRR Memorial Hermann recently became the first Houston area host site for the U.S. Department of State Global Sports Mentoring Program: Sport for Community (GSMP), which is implemented by The University of Tennessee's Center for Sport, Peace, and Society.

Each year, GSMP provides approximately 15 international leaders in the disability sport sector with opportunities to participate in its five-week exchange program in the United States. Delegates are matched with executives at leading disability sport organizations across the U.S.

TIRR Memorial Hermann will host Klaithem Almatrooshi, Head of Female Section and Deputy Chairwoman at the Al Thiqah Club for Handicapped in the United Arab Emirates city of Sharjah.

"We are honored to have Klaithem here to learn more and work with our Adaptive Sports Program," said Jerry Ashworth, CEO of TIRR Memorial Hermann. "TIRR is committed to improving the lives of people with disabilities in the Houston community and throughout the world through collaborations and initiatives such as the Global Sports Mentoring Program."

In her current role, Almatrooshi trains volunteers on how to work with people with motor disabilities, coordinates with trainers on the details of tournaments and competitions, and works with staff to meet the needs of female members of Al Thiqah Club for Handicapped. She also provides social and psychological support by conducting case studies and fulfilling the needs of disability cases.

"What I hope to learn most at TIRR Memorial Hermann is how to transfer best practices in the field of disabilities and adapt them to the UAE in order to advocate for Emiratis with disabilities as effective citizens in society," Almatrooshi said. "I want to enrich my skills and awareness of disability sports and techniques in the United States. I look forward to learning how to support families of those with disabilities because they are the first and most important partners in the development of their children."

Peggy Turner, Adaptive Sports Coordinator at TIRR Memorial Hermann, will serve as Almatrooshi's mentor.

"This is a great opportunity for TIRR Memorial Hermann to make an impact in the lives of athletes with disabilities thousands of miles away," Turner said. "I look forward to working with Klaithem to identify new practices and opportunities for the members of the

Al Thiqah Club in Sharjah.”

Almatrooshi will be leading the planning of the International Wheelchair and Amputee Sports Federation World Games in the UAE later this year. She also spreads awareness about the Al Thiqah Club and its services through participation in television interviews that cover the Club’s activities.

“I also want to help change the media discourse and view of disabilities in the UAE so that they cover disability issues in a realistic manner,” Almatrooshi said.

Participants in the GSMP immerse themselves in the day-to-day activities of their mentors and learn more about sports programs for people with disabilities. At the end of the program, participants travel to Washington, D.C., to present strategic action plans based on what they learned before returning home to implement those measures in their countries.

“We are humbled to walk alongside Klaithem who is working diligently to make a difference for persons with disabilities in the UAE,” said Sarah Hillyer, clinical assistant professor and director of the Center for Sport, Peace, and Society at The University of Tennessee, Knoxville. “Thanks to the support and investment of mentors like Peggy and host organizations like TIRR Memorial Hermann, we continue to see the power of sport being used in innovative ways to create more inclusive communities.”

In 2018, the GSMP: Sport for Community was named “Diplomatic Action of the Year” at the Peace and Sport Awards in Greece. Its sister program, Global Sports Mentoring Program which is in partnership with espnW and focuses on empowering women, was named a Stuart Scott ENSPIRE Award at the ESPN Humanitarian awards.

In addition to its comprehensive approach to clinical care, research and education, TIRR Memorial Hermann focuses on taking care of the community to truly impact and serve its patients through advocacy in order to help patients achieve more in their recoveries.

“Advocacy is woven into our fabric and an important element of what we do at TIRR Memorial Hermann and we are committed to raising awareness, educating people about the inequalities that exist and removing barriers,” Ashworth said. “We advocate through our community wellness program and through our adapted sports programs.”

The TIRR Memorial Hermann Adaptive Sports Program was developed in the mid-1990s to give athletes with all types of disabilities an outlet to continue playing sports both competitively and through intramural programs, including: basketball, rugby, hand cycling and ultimate frisbee.

Bird Bath Bliss

The heat is on! Just like us, birds enjoy and need a clean drink of water and a cooling bath. You can do birds a great service by providing a birdbath where they can drink, bathe and preen. Here is some helpful information regarding birdbaths.

- Birds aren't going to swim in it so it doesn't have to be deep. They only partially submerge their bodies so the optimal depth is from 1 to 3 inches.

- The bottom of your birdbath should not be slippery. If it is, you can add small rocks to the bottom.

- Birds are attracted by moving water so if you want to attract a larger number of birds, you should consider purchasing one with that feature. If you already have a birdbath, you can purchase a piece to attach to it. There are also misters available for purchase.

- Your birdbath need not be fancy. Trust me, birds don't care. The color, shape and style is of little importance

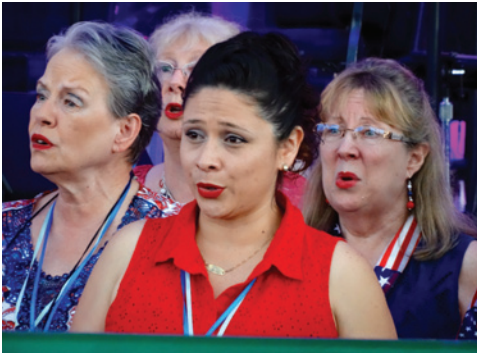
- A dirty birdbath is hazardous to birds. Stagnant water can harbor unhealthy concentrations of bacteria that cause diseases. Stagnant water can also attract mosquitoes that may carry diseases dangerous to both humans and birds. There are numerous soaps and cleansers on the market but the best solution to keeping your birdbath clean is to mix nine parts water to one part vinegar. Chemicals found in commercial cleaners can strip birds of essential oils in their feathers. Scrub your birdbath with the solution and a brush and rinse, rinse, rinse. Be sure to refill the birdbath every couple of days. There are self-cleaning, self-filling units on the market, too, although you can expect to pay considerably more for those.

- In our part of the country, it doesn't get extremely cold in the winter but you can add a heater to the birdbath if you wish. Just search for birdbath heaters on the web.

TWRC Wildlife Center is admitting hundreds of baby birds right now and some are coming to us needlessly. When baby birds are old enough, they will leave the nest before they are able to fly. They will spend several days on the ground until their flight feathers develop. These birds are called fledglings. Before picking up the fledgling, wait and observe. In most cases you'll see Mom watching over them and feeding them. If you don't see Mom after a period of time, it's okay to rescue the bird and bring it to us for care. Do not attempt to feed it or give it water! Keep in safe and warm in a box and get it to us as quickly as possible. If you have any questions, you can call us at 713.468.8972. 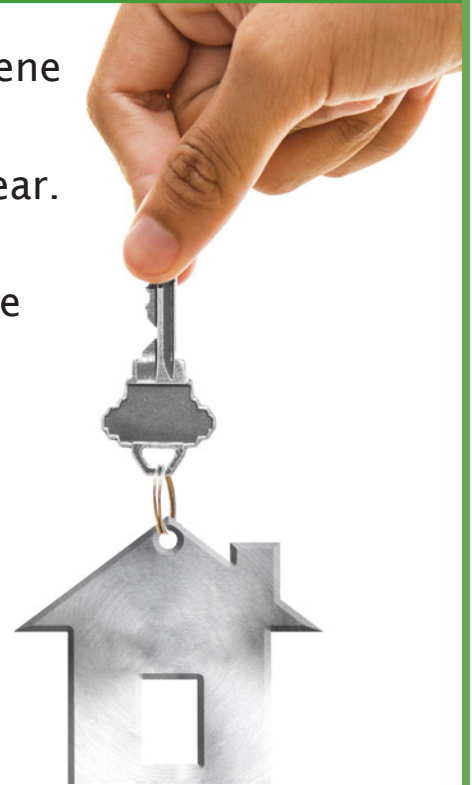
