The Texas Veterans Land Board offers long-term care for qualified Veterans, their spouses and Gold Star Parents. Applications are currently being accepted. Apply now at vlb.texas.gov. TBCSVI is proud to honor and support the Texas Veterans Land Board.

Texas State Veterans Homes are owned by the state of Texas and regulated by both the Texas Health and Human Services Commission as well as the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). Third-party operators manage the day-to-day operations of the Veterans homes. The Texas Veterans Land Board oversees the operators and has an on-site representative in each Veterans home. The VA does not own or manage Texas State Veterans Homes.

There are many advantages to living in a Texas State Veterans Home from the Veteran-centered care, the VA per diem that helps alleviate some costs of care (including medication and therapy) and the camaraderie of living with fellow Veterans who have similar life experiences.

Texas State Veterans Homes serve a very special and unique population, and thus provides all employees with specialized training to help them understand the military experience as well as post-traumatic stress. Alternative therapy modalities, including equine, art, music and pet therapies, are available for residents to improve their quality of life. Physical, occupational and speech therapy are also offered at each home.



From: The Mayo Clinic Diet

FRESH PUTTANESCA WITH BROWN RICE

This recipe is a little labor intensive with all of the chopping, but well worth the effort. It may also be served over toasted garlic bread.

- 4 c. plum tomatoes
- 1 T. olive oil
- 4 whole Kalamata olives, pitted 1/4 c. fresh basil
- 4 whole green olives, pitted
- 1 T. parsley
- 1 ½ T. capers
- 1/8 t. red pepper flakes
- 1 T. garlic, minced
- 3 c. brown rice, cooked
- 1. In a large bowl, combine the tomatoes, olives, capers, garlic and oil.
- 2. Add basil, parsley and red pepper flakes, stirring to combine.
 - 3. Serve over hot cooked rice or toasted garlic bread.
